Manchester United have sacked Ole Gunnar Solskjær after an embarrassing defeat at the hands of Claudio Ranieri's Watford.

Man Utd drop to seventh place with 17 points, 12 behind leaders Chelsea.

This was Solskjær's last game in charge. He has built an incredible squad at Manchester United but has never brought them to the next level the way Pep or Klopp have done with City and Liverpool and arguably a better squad than these teams.
